2-Day Training Cancellation Policy & Required Materials

Cancellations

If you must cancel your registration for a class:

- If you cancel at least 14 days or more prior to the start of class, you will be refunded the registration fees you have paid minus a \$100 processing fee, or you may apply the fee toward another training within one year.
- If you cancel between 2 and 13 days prior to the start of the class, you will be refunded the registration fees you have paid minus a \$175 processing fee, or you may apply the fee toward another training within one year.
- If you cancel within 48 hours of the class WITH NOTICE, you may apply the registration fees you have paid toward another training within one year.
- If you do not show up for the class you will forfeit all fees paid – No refunds, no credit.

If Amaryllis Therapy Network cancels a class you may choose to be refunded in full or apply the fee towards the next training at our facility.

Certification Completion

Our weekend training is brief but jam-packed with information. Here is what will be expected of you after the training in order to complete your CIMI certification.

Exam Process: The written exam is a take-home open book format, so we encourage you to read through and familiarize yourself with the required books before the training.

Practical Exam: The second half of the CIMI certification exam involves teaching infant massage to a minimum of four families, in multiple sessions per family. We recommend getting started now with organizing your parents and babies for the practicum. After the course, you will have two months to complete these sessions. The families' evaluations and your notes of the sessions can then be sent directly to Loving Touch.

Once all of the course requirements have been completed you will receive certification through the Loving Touch Foundation.
